AYUSH and Modern Medicine Integrated Holistic Clinic and wellness centre in SMBT Hospital OPD

आयुष्पान सेवा केंद्र. Here is a brief account of yesterday's progress on Interpathy clinic. Integrated approach on several ailments and about wellness is a new initiative by GOI, although such effort is rooted in the past and has a rich history. Incidentally many modern medicines are active principles of old world remedies including Ayurveda. At SMBT we would like to start a joint effort for integrated management of select ailments/health problems and a wellness initiative. Primarily this would be a cooperative project between SMBT Ayurved College and SMBT medical college hospital. Here is a brief outline of the project Integrated Treatment and Wellness Center. We need to coin a Marathi name for this. Holistic Clinic can be named as Ayushman Clinic आयुष्पान/ संयुक्त आरोग्य सेवा केंद्र in Marathi.

1. Rationale

Human health and wellness needs a holistic approach. India is endowed with a rich legacy of AYUSH. We have both modern medicine and Ayurveda colleges in the SMBT campus. With a synergistic approach we can open a joint treatment and wellness clinic in SMBT hospital OPD with support from various depts. Many NCDs (non-Communicable diseases) chronic pain and even some communicable diseases may be well managed with integrated approach. We need a scientific and rational approach.

- · This clinic is mainly for referrals from other specialities
- But there will be a board in waiting hall about this facility and patients will be routed through respective specialities for Interpathy clinic held as per schedule (Patients will sent to the IP clinic on specific days-which is a limitation for now)

3. Speciality-wise shortlist of health problems

Primarily we can focus on some ailments and develop protocols. The MUHS also has a dept of inter-pathy research. Following 15 health problems can be shortlisted for collaborative management in this clinic

- Medicine: CVD, COPD, GERD-Gastro Esophageal Reflux Disease, IBS Chronic gastritis.
- OBGYN: Menorrhagia, Pelvic inflammatory disease (PID).
- Paediatrics: Childhood malnutrition, U5 failure to thrive.
- Orthopedics: chronic arthritis, back-pain.
- Geriatric: Geriatric health problems, chronic pains due to various causes including cancers.



4. Framework for collaboration

All faculty are requested to develop a comprehensive framework/ approach for the IP clinic activity for their speciality sitting with concerned AYUSH expert, working on known advances and experiences of running the clinic on pilot basis till end of December 2020. Here is a suggestive template/framework you can use for this purpose.

6. Logistic support

The dept of PSM will help in coordination of IP clinic. Other depts. to help will be GAD, Pharmacy, Lab services, MRD. Two interns will be posted by dept of CM in this clinic to help coordination and data management with help of MRD. We will use national protocols/standard treatment guidelines for disease management for both MM and Ayurveda, but have freedom for reasonable variation.

7. Record keeping and monitoring

A standard format will be developed jointly by clinical faculty including CM and MRD. This will be generated and tested till April 2021 for final version.

8. Inter institutional Interpathy committee involvement

SMBT campus has many institutes and there is an Interpathy committee established in Nov 2020. This committee will oversee and participate in the proceedings of IP clinic apart from committee functions.

9. Suggestions to HODs for patient referral to IP clinic संयुक्त उपचार.

A framework has to be evolved for referral of patients (with due consent) for referring to this clinic. Primarily each dept and faculty will select patients for this purpose and direct them to IP clinic on the right weekday as per schedule. WE will also take walk in patients on experimental basis. But the primary responsibility for referral will be with the listed depts. in IP clinic. A color code will be used for additional case sheet for referral from usual specialties to the IP clinic. Any panchkarma required will be done in the Ayurveda College.

10. Wellness centre & geriatric care

On Thursdays, the dept of Community Medicine will hold a specialised OPD for geriatric services and wellness, along with Ayurved expert.

11. Research Component

The IP clinic is a joint service center with research unit. The operational aspects of the IP clinic will be aligned with overall research /development agenda for Interpathy.

12. Timeline

The protocols to be developed by 22nd Feb 2021, the clinic should start from 15th March 2021.
